

Each one of these is called a CHANNEL

Input Selector : all should be on 'A' except Channel 1

Allows Channel to be on air: This button should ALWAYS be down when live on air

Used when pre-recording or listening 'off-air'

Not used

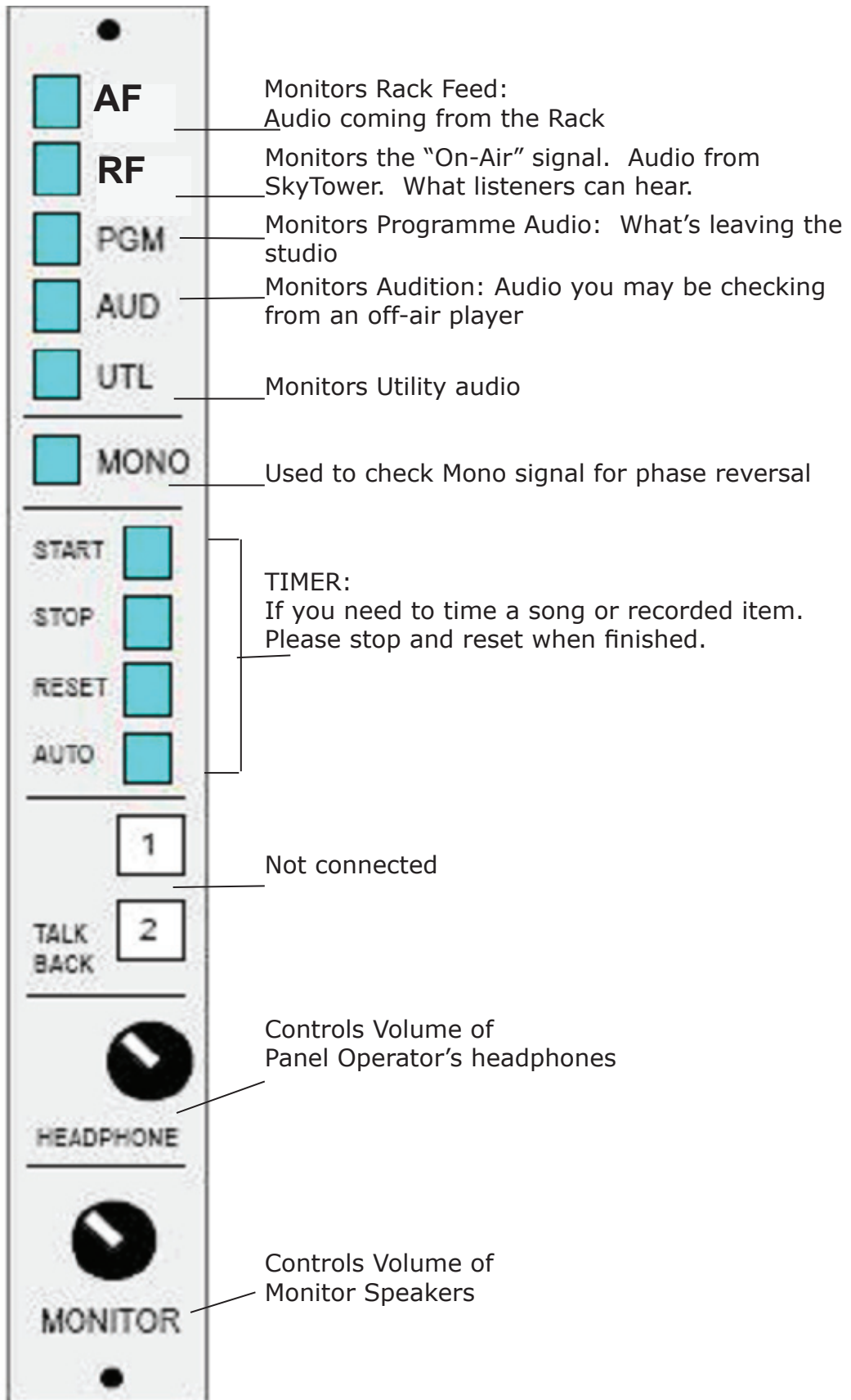
FADER: Used to control LEVELS

CUE: When fader is pushed below last line it goes into Cue

ON: Used to switch channel on

OFF: Used to switch channel off
